Residential Levels of Care Glossary

Residential Treatment

Structured support 24 hours/day

Rehabilitation Treatment

Residents receive intensive clinical treatment each day. This includes individual and group counseling (mental health, substance use, vocational, family counseling) and onsite medical professionals (basic primary care)

Reintegration Programs

These programs assist people in learning to skills it takes to be independent. They also provide supportive environments as they pursue work, volunteer opportunities, or educational goals. In addition, independent and group counseling sessions are available on site. These programs also focus on connecting residents to the following community resources: Outpatient treatment, Primary and specialty medical care, Mental health services, Education and vocational services.

Supportive Living

Peer supported apartments within the community. Residents are linked with outpatient counseling and other support services.
