  - Led development of Coordinated Community Plan to End Youth Homelessness
  - Led the development of new projects serving youth experiencing homelessness
  - Provided consultation to agencies to develop their programs and staff hiring
  - Hosted the Speak Out! End Youth Homelessness event
  - Participated in the youth specific Point in Time county
  - o Participated in the Couch-a-thon
  - Developed goals and strategies to sustain the YAB and advocate for social justice
