Due to staff turnover and other organizational staffing issue, the project has not been reached to their capacity for in the past 3 years. The project voluntarily reduced their request amount and will be serving 62 households rather than 68. After meeting with the Project Selection Committee, we discussed the appropriate amount for the new capacity. Notification is sent out to the applicant via email on July 22, 2022.


