Due to staff turnover and organizational changes, the program has not been able to meet the proposed capacity. After two years of concerted efforts to address these challenges, the Project Selection Committee has decided to reallocate the funding and seek a replacement organization. The grantee was formally notified of this decision via email on July 3, 2024.




